The rink is a great way to teach children the benefits of an active lifestyle. TAM's mission is connecting people through art, and with CHI Franciscan Polar Plaza, we also get to connect people through sport. We welcome skaters to stop by TAM and stretch their creative skills in the free TAM Studio, too."
