

Based on the 1885 city directory and 1885 Sanborn Fire Insurance maps. Tacoma, 1885—Commerce Street was Railroad, Broadway was C Street, and Market was D Street. First single letters denote direction (west, south, etc.); second "s" means side of the street; #-letter (e.g. "4 n") means number of buildings in the direction (four buildings north); "bet" is between; "nr" is near, "N P" is Northern Pacific Railroad, and "cor" is corner.
