Join Tacoma Art Museum and partners in celebrating the **16th Annual Día de los Muertos** virtually with TAM!

Due to the current pandemic, Day of the Dead at TAM will be celebrated virtually this year to help keep our community healthy.

In honor of *Día de los Muertos*, Tacoma Art Museum invites individuals and groups to create altar installations to be a part of our virtual Ofrenda (altar) exhibition. Exhibition dates are October 31 - November 15, 2020.

Altars are a traditional aspect of *Día de los Muertos*. People create altars to honor the lives of those who have passed. Altars range from simple to very elaborate and are usually filled with photographs and objects that were dear to the departed. They are made with loving care and filled with *ofrendas* (offerings).

Participants will share their ofrenda through photographs, videos, and written elements that will be compiled by TAM for the first-ever virtual altar exhibition, hosted at TacomaArtMuseum.org.
